

<u>SAFETY – April is Dig Safe Month Across Canada!</u>

Whether you are a homeowner or farmer taking on an outdoor project or a contractor planning an excavation, it is critical to plan and be aware of what's below the ground prior to completing any ground disturbance.

ONE CALL COSTS YOU NOTHING, NOT CALLING COULD COST YOU EVERYTHING!

When you submit a locate request through Utility Safety Partners (Formerly Call Before You Dig & Alberta One-Call), it records all information related to your locate request on a Ticket. Your Ticket is sent to each registered utility owner (Members of Utility Safety Partners) affected by your excavation. You will be provided with the Ticket Number associated with your request.

Within a minimum of three full working days (unless it is a large project), the notified utility owners or their approved contract locator will contact you, or will visit the site to mark the location of the buried lines using water-soluble paint or flags. You will also receive communication which will include a drawing of buried lines in conflict with the dig area and instructions on how to dig safely.

Rockyview Gas Co-op Ltd. is a proud member of Utility Safety Partners. All Utility Safety Partners members provide locate services at no charge to the excavator.


Purpose of Meeting:

CARBON LEVY IMPACT

FEDERAL FUEL CHARGE INCREASE EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2022

The current price of \$40 per tonne (of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO2e) emissions) for heating fuels will increase on April 1, 2022 to \$50 per tonne. These rates are prescribed by the Government of Canada on an increasing scale and were scheduled to increase to \$50 per tonne by April 2022.

Natural Gas Utilities are required to charge these rates as per the federal Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. All fees charged under this Act are remitted directly to Revenue Canada.

On April 1, 2022, this charge will increase to \$2.63/GJ.

The new rate will be automatically applied to your bill for natural gas consumed beginning April 1, 2022.
