

CARBON LEVY IMPACT

FEDERAL FUEL CHARGE INCREASE EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2023

The current price of \$50 per tonne (of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO2e) emissions) for heating fuels will increase on April 1, 2023 to \$65 per tonne.

Natural Gas Utilities are required to charge these rates as per the federal Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. All fees charged under this Act are remitted directly to Revenue Canada.

On April 1, 2023, this charge will increase to \$3.33/GJ.

The new rate will be automatically applied to your bill for natural gas consumed beginning April 1, 2023.
