Regarding: Leak Detection Survey Utilizing Remotely Piloted Aircraft System

Rockyview Gas Co-op Ltd. will be completing a leak detection survey starting on May 11, 2023 and it continue over a 2-3 day period. As part of this survey, we will be gathering leak detection data from the low-pressure lines contained within our franchise area.

Our contractor, Current Surveillance Inc., will be flying a RPAS (remotely piloted aircraft system) to complete the survey. The equipment used will be a Matrice 600 Drone (RPAV) with a methane detector. It will be operating in a random pattern, at an elevation up to 100 meters above ground level. This mission and flight area will be approved by Transport Canada through a Special Flight Operations Certificate and a filed Flight Plan approval.

Please be assured that your safety and privacy are at the utmost importance to Rockyview Gas Co-op Ltd. and Current Surveillance Inc. Current Surveillance is committed to safe and responsible remotely piloted aircraft services. As required by law, Current Surveillance only flies when permitted by Transport Canada and all other applicable authorities.
